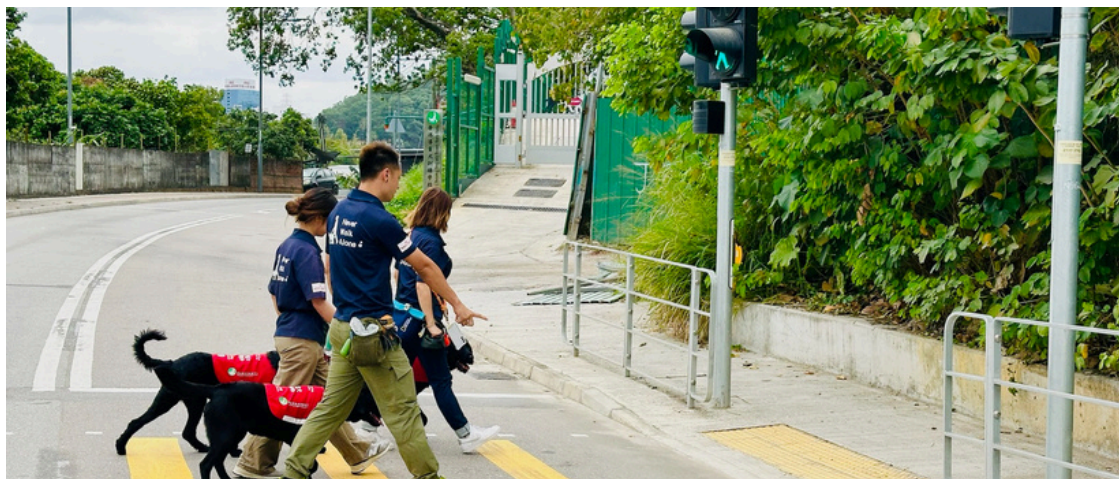

香港導盲犬訓練學校的校舍位於打鼓嶺蓮麻坑路，由已空置多年的三和公立學校活化而成，佔地約24,500平方呎。從物色用地到竣工歷時逾四年。訓練學校設施包括斑馬線、紅綠燈和行人天橋等設施，目的是讓導盲犬和視障人士在安全且貼近真實的環境下接受訓練。此外，中心提供國際級水平的師資，提供專業的導盲犬服務，並致力於培育本地導盲犬。香港導盲犬訓練學校將成為香港導盲犬服務的搖籃，開啓本地導盲犬服務的新篇章！





## CHAIRPERSON'S WORDS

School facilities include: traffic light road crossing, pedestrian walking bridge etc. To model real surroundings in which SEDS and their partners may be trained in a safe area.

Also, HKSEDS' trainers and seeing eye dog services are of international professional standards, and we embrace local breeding program to further enhance development of seeing eye dogs in Hong Kong.

Our Seeing Eye Dog School will be the cradle to guide dog services in Hong Kong and mark the opening of a new chapter in the history of local guide dog services.



## 使用者分享 VIVIAN AND ALEX



不經不覺，與 Coby 相處了近七年的時間，因着Coby 確診了癌症，他已於 2023 年 2 月 24 日在寄養家庭中安祥離世，同日也是我新到任導盲犬 Vivian 的生日，就像是 Coby 將領路的責任交付與 Vivian，這一天別具意義。

回想與 Vivian 接觸的第一次，知道她有機會替代 Coby的工作時，我是既興奮，又猶豫。一方面 Coby 確診癌症後，已未能再擔負領路的工作，但事出突然，那時的我頓失依靠，再次使用白杖，外出時總是處處碰壁，生活總是提不起勁。然而，當我嘗試由Vivian領路時，我覺得她步履太跳脫且急速，再加上她恰巧與我的直屬上師同名，總之我有千百個理由不想由 Vivian 接替Coby的工作。好不容易，我下定了決心，最終讓 Vivian接手 Coby的工作。

Vivian 是一個需要關係才可以履行職務的「僱員」；也有一定程度的「固執」，在起初一起生活的日子裡，她偶然就會「拉布」- 名符其實的「拉布拉多犬」。每次她「對著幹」時，都大大動搖了我對導盲犬的信心。隨著時間的推移，彼此間多了一份信任及默契，而我也更掌握及了解 Vivian 的特質。時至今日「拉布」的情況已漸漸消滅，而她也有更大的信心為我開關道路，帶我安全而快速地前往目的地，大大提高了我的生活質素。當然，這段關係是有代價的，代價或許是「幸福肥」作怪，換來了 Vivian 的大肚子，也似乎是時候還原的「靚靚權」。

## USER SHARING - VIVIAN AND ALEX

Seven years pacing along with dearest partner Coby passed by unconsciously. Following his cancer diagnosis, Coby passed away peacefully at our Puppy Walker family's home on 24 Feb 2023. Coincidentally, Vivian's birthday as well as 'Changing of the guard' day from Coby to Vivian. A very significant day for me with mixed feelings.

Looking back at meeting Vivian for the first time, and the possibility of her replacing Coby as my guiding partner, I felt excited yet also hesitant at the idea. Announcement of Coby's cancer diagnosis was sudden, which meant he could no longer perform his duties and I had to rely on using my mobility cane once more. Constantly bumping into obstacles along my daily ventures was challenging and I lost drive and enthusiasm during those difficult times of my life. Nevertheless, adapting to Vivian's guidance was a new learning curve. Her steps were brisk and carefree. Also, coincidentally she had the same name as my manager at the office, another excuse for not accepting Vivian as Coby's replacement. Eventually I overcame these hurdles and accepted Vivian to take over from Coby's duties and become my new partner.

Vivian has a rather stubborn character so need to manage relationship with her well before wheels of a content employee could be turned smoothly. During the early stages of our partnership, she used to, from time to time 'play-up', playing her delay tactics during our journeys, which was not desirable. Each time she 'played-up', my confidence in seeing eye dogs fell to an all time low.

As time went by, our bonding and trust increased and our relationship became much closer. Vivian played up much less, confidently opened up pathways and guided me along busy streets towards my destination swiftly and safely, enhancing my quality of life substantially. As the saying goes, successes come at a price – Vivian's jolly pot belly! It's time now to work on reverting her back to a slimmer beauty!

Finally I would like to send my sincere heart felt gratitude to Hong Kong Seeing Eye Dog Services and both puppy walker families, for their care, love and dedication in nurturing Coby and Vivian through their journey to become excellent guiding angels to us.

Also special thanks to our trainers for guiding me through my most difficult emotional journey. Despite their heavy work load, provided their time and expertise in assisting us navigating to and from new home, new office, training my colleagues skills in care and acceptance of Vivian in the workplace.

The team demonstrated their training skills once more, tamed the two terrors and taught them to accept Fairy into the household and showed them how to live peacefully together.

Looking back on the past fruitful year, Fairy has not only safely guided me across our bustling city, she has also been an inseparable partner, filled my life with colour and joy, my mental inspiration and life companion. Her care and dedication towards me is totally unconditional despite my visual impairment. She is law abiding, crossing roads at the right places, guiding me along busy streets, interwinding through crowds towards my destination, making sure I am in safe hands. She has brought me laughter at times and truly my darling angel. I treasure my angel and promise to take good care of her, provide her with the favourite foods, love, care, warmth and comfort. She is my inspiration, we shall venture on through our journeys ahead together. We shall Never Walk Alone!





## 訓練員分享 - 蔡嘉祺小姐 SED TRAINER SHARING - MS. CHOI KA KI, CAR

第一次了解導盲犬是在2004年的一套電影 - 導盲犬小Q，因為自己很喜歡狗的關係，有關狗的電影我都會看。看到小Q由一隻小狗，到寄養家庭生活至入訓練學校，第一次與怕狗的渡邊先生接觸，最後如何與渡邊先生配合及生活，成爲一隻合格的導盲犬，都令我十分動容。

2022年適逢疫情，在尋找工作的過程中，我看到香港導盲犬服務中心正在招聘文員，協助籌備香港導盲犬訓練學校開幕禮，當時我第一時間就想到導盲犬小Q這套電影，希望可以多了解導盲犬，於是就入職成爲兼職文員。

在工作期間，我接觸到不同部門的同事，如市場部、寄養家庭部和訓練部等。和他們聊天過程中都了解到不同部門對導盲犬的付出，如市場策劃部負責推廣導盲犬的資訊；寄養家庭部負責照顧幼犬及幫助導盲幼犬做社會化訓練；訓練部則負責教導導盲犬尋找目標物及避障障礙物。當中最吸引我的就是訓練員，看到訓練員蒙著眼讓導盲犬帶領他們由起點至目的地，令我再次想起渡邊先生和小Q從不信任到互相信任，使我十分感動，從而立志成爲一名導盲犬訓練員，培訓出更多導盲犬幫助視障人士，希望未來能順利實現目標。



My first encounter with guide dogs was from a film I watched back in 2004 called 'Little Q'. As a fond dog lover, any film on dogs caught my attention.

The film depicted how 'Little Q' was supported by his Puppy Walker family as a young pup, socialization training and getting to know the world, onto guide dog school, being paired with Mr. Watanabe, meeting him for the first time and the story of how 'Little Q' became a qualified guide dog and how they ventured through life's journey together overwhelmed me.

Whilst searching for new work opportunities post COVID in 2022, I noticed an administration post by HKSEDS, to assist with the grand opening of their guide dog training school. This immediately triggered my attention and memories of the film 'Little Q'. As I wanted to get to know more about guide dogs, thus applied and became part time administrator at HKSEDS.

Inevitably, whilst working with staff members of various departments: Training, Marketing, Puppy Walker, conversations with them enhanced my understanding and how much collective effort has been put into the development of our guide dog program. Marketing department are responsible for promoting our services, Puppy Walkers responsible for early pup training, welfare and socialization, and Training department teaching them to find target objects and guide around obstructing obstacles.

Trainers attracted my attention the most, watching them blind folded, allowing our dogs to guide them from start to end of their destination.

This gave me flash backs to "Little Q' and Mr. Watanabe again. How strangers at first, working hand in hand, building trust and a solid relationship together. This was absolutely amazing and touched me deeply. Thus, I wanted to also become a guide dog trainer.

## 寄養家庭分享 PUPPY WALKER FAMILY SHARING

我兩夫婦退休後，參與香港導盲犬服務中心的寄養家庭義工計劃，為中心照顧導盲幼犬Vivian。自牠約五個月大的時候已經來到我們家生活，我倆帶Vivian外出走動，做社會化訓練，我們的活動也因而多了，也建立健康快樂的關係。在照顧Vivian期間，經常到一些寵物犬進不到的場所和設施進行訓練，見證住Vivian的成長與進步，這也是我們做寄養家庭義工最大的期望。

## 公眾教育

## PUBLIC EDUCATION



公眾教育是我們香港導盲犬服務中心的一項核心使命，這是一項永不止步的服務。我們必須持續不斷地通過公眾教育，讓更多市民了解導盲犬服務的重要性，同時糾正社會上對導盲犬的一些誤解和偏見。

### 公眾教育的挑戰與應對

在2022-2023年度，儘管面對COVID-19疫情的持續影響和限聚令的實施，我們仍然努力推動公眾教育活動。然而，受限於防疫措施，導盲犬講座的申請數量大幅減少，從去年的86場減半至47場。儘管講座場次減少，但令人欣慰的是，參加人數稍有上升，這表明公眾對導盲犬服務的關注度有所提升。

### 創新的教育形式

為了打破面對面接觸的限制，我們本年度在社交媒體平台上推出了一系列創新的公眾教育活動。其中，最為成功的是在Facebook上發佈的「導盲犬話當年」專題報導，共13集。這些報導回顧了香港導盲犬服務的歷史，特別是1975年盧光圻先生得到資助前往澳洲皇家導盲犬協會受訓，並帶同導盲犬Winta回港的故事。這些故事不僅展示了導盲犬服務在香港的發展歷程，也讓更多人了解導盲犬對視障人士的重要性。

這些線上報導取得了很好的反響，不僅增加了公眾對導盲犬服務的認識，也為那些無法參加實體講座的人士提供了學習的機會。我們邀請所有對導盲犬歷史和服務感興趣的朋友，瀏覽我們的Facebook專頁，了解更多精彩內容。

## 公眾教育

## PUBLIC EDUCATION



Public education is one of the core missions of HKSEDS. It's a never ending service which we must carry out continuously, to alert the general public of the important services of Seeing Eye Dogs, overcome misinterpretations and bias.

Our approach to challenges on public education - The impact of COVID and related restrictions during 2022 – 2023 has drastically affected our public education program but our service has not halted. Education talks has fallen from 86 of the previous year to just 47 sessions this year. However, one consolation, number of attendees has increased from last year, which may imply that the public are more inclined to learn and understand more about Seeing Eye Dogs and their services.

Innovative educating approach - As face-to-face interactions are limited, we transferred our approach to reach out to the public via social media platform – Facebook.

One of our most successful series posted on Facebook has been a special program with 13 episodes about the 'Early years of SEDs'. This series, introducing the history of seeing eye dogs in Hong Kong from 1975 especially, the story of how Mr. Lo Kwong Yan was offered sponsorship to the Royal Guide Dog Association in Australia to accept guide dog training, and returning home with his SED Winta.

This story not only introduced the history of SEDs in Hong Kong, it has also allowed the public to understand the importance of SEDs to the visually impaired.

Such online reports have received much acclaim, not only vastly increased public knowledge of SEDS, also enabling persons unable to attend face to face sessions the opportunity to learn more about the subject. We welcome and encourage members of the public showing interest on the subject to visit our Facebook page to gain further insights and latest updates on Seeing Eye Dogs and our services.



## 國際交流及培訓



作為國際導盲犬聯盟（IGDF）的會員，香港導盲犬服務中心一直以國際標準來訓練導盲犬及培育導盲幼犬。即便在過去幾年受新冠肺炎疫情影響，中心的培訓工作也從未間斷。2022年秋天，我們再次邀請到來自美國OccuPaws Guide Dog Association的導盲犬訓練師（GDMI），Dennis Walker先生，來香港進行為期三個月的交流與指導。

## INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS

As member of the International Guide Dog Federation (IGDF), HKSEDS has continued to train our Seeing Eye Dogs (SED) as well as nurture young pups in accordance to the high international standards. During COVID epidemic years, we continued with our SED training programs, our work has not halted. In the autumn of 2022, we once again invited Mr. Dennis Walker, Guide Dog Trainer (GDMI) of OccuPaws Guide Dog Association from the USA, on a 3 months exchange and training program to our staff.

### Importance of International Exchange

During his 3 month training exchange program with us, Dennis not only embraced us with training concepts, advanced training skills and techniques, he also answered many of our queries and concerns regarding SED training and related issues. Especially now we are embarking on a new journey at our training school.

With various facilities, Dennis provided comprehensive training to our training staff with new techniques on SED guidance training, kennel management, how to proceed with the best matching of SED with their potential user. This exchange program has not only upgraded the professional standard of our SED trainers, it has also given our cadets the opportunity to learn and gain additional knowledge in this field.

### Promotion of Positive Reinforcement Training

Positive Reinforcement is our core concept in the training of SEDs.

This method places emphasis in rewarding and encouraging SEDs, to nurture and bring out their best behavior. During his time in Hong Kong, Dennis especially emphasized the importance of positive reinforcement training, provided knowledge and professional hands on training techniques to our trainers' and cadets. Enabling us to use these new techniques in training pups in the future, raising our professional standards to another level.

This experience and knowledge allow us to use positive reinforcement techniques to improve our standard in our training going forward, thus hopefully improving the quality and standard of new SED.

We believe with the improvement of school facilities and opening up of international exchange programs, the development of SED services in Hong Kong will reach another new peak. In future, we will continue to train SEDs to a high level, providing the best qualified and professional service to our visually impaired persons as well as continued development of SED services in Hong Kong.

We thank all friends in support and participation in these international exchange programs. Your support has enabled us to continuously improve at the international level, providing the visually impaired with hope and light at the end of the tunnel.

## FUND RAISING

Explore more effective ways, safety being paramount, to enhance fund raising opportunities. ## 義工招募和發展

### VOLUNTEER RECRUITMENT AND DEVELOPMENT

HKSEDS' volunteer has been faced with many challenges during year 2022-23, COVID epidemic being the major factor. Despite this, our volunteer puppy walker families have not halted their contributions in caring and training of our young pups.

They spend 14 hours daily in caring for our pups, includes: feeding, hygiene care, socialization training, taking them out on walks, to bring them up to standard for future guidance training.

With the advent of COVID, there has been uncertain times where larger dogs reported to have contracted COVID. This has impacted our volunteer recruitment as many resisted to approach our pups for health and safety reason which is understandable. Recruitment in this sector has not been satisfactory.

Other area of voluntary assistance has been impacted more severely by COVID, especially with outdoor work. Although restrictions has been relaxed, many are still reluctant to venture out or spend prolonged hours at locations where large numbers congregate.

To combat these challenges, we set out various measures in place. Educated our volunteers on healthcare and protection knowledge, provided them with the necessary protective supplies, guidelines on safety working practices in order to overcome their concerns.

Going forward, after COVID has subsided, we hope to maintain and expand our volunteer team, help to create hope and brighten up lives of our visually impaired friends and make a difference to their quality of life. With your help and dedication, we wish to continue working together to create a warm, inclusive society for our friends in need.

# FUTURE DEVELOPMENT

As COVID has slowly parted ways with us, we have embarked on a positive new stage, filled with opportunities. All epidemic restrictions has been lifted, this has greatly improve our operating environment and allowed all our functions to operate more smoothly and effectively. At this critical time, HKSEDS has reached another important new milestone. our Seeing Eye Dog School opened in December 2022.

## Opening of Seeing Eye Dog Training School

The opening of our Seeing Eye Dog Training School shall greatly improve our level and ability in training of Seeing Eye Dogs. We hope the school will be the core fundamental training ground where Seeing Eye Dog users will learn and sought comprehensive training and become accustomed to the surroundings. Also, we plan to carry out guided tours of our school, not only will this new service educate the public on importance and training of Seeing Eye Dogs, will also increase their knowledge and support towards our Seeing Eye Dog service. This will also be a main income source towards funding of our free Seeing Eye Dog service to the visually impaired.

## School Operations and Financial Challenges

With school in full operation, we are confronted with a new set of financial challenges. Firstly, maintenance of school facilities and operation guidelines, setting up and implementation of codes are basic fundamentals of school operation. Yet, operating expenditure is most essential. Establishment of new school will inevitably increase our financial burden. We need to set up good financial management and alternative strategies in fund raising to overcome this new challenge.

## Fund Raising

On fund raising, we shall continue to explore into other resources, combination of online and traditional channels, strengthening our relationship and cooperation with commercial and social entities. We believe broadening our network of channels will attract more support and donations, thus lift us out of our financial burden.

## Professional Development

On professional development, we shall strengthen training of staff and volunteers to increase their technical skills, service quality. We plan to invite experts from international guide dog institutions on exchange training programs to maintain our training services at international standards.



## FUTURE DEVELOPMENT

### School Management and Personnel Placement

We shall create comprehensive management systems to ensure smooth and efficient running of our establishment. This will include creation of detailed operating and emergency contingency plans. These will be revised from time to time as required due to changes in circumstances. Personnel deployment, ensuring we have the most suitable talents deployed in each position for the future and development of our center.

### Establishment of Companion Dog Service

We are in the process of creating a new Companion Dog service. We shall utilize pups unable to pass through as qualified Seeing Eye Dogs, change their role to serve the public in an alternative role. Companion Dogs shall be deployed in elder care homes, providing 'relief' and support service to patients; their presence may bring happiness and even improve mental stress to residents at the home. This will not only bring out hidden potentials of our pups, will also relief supplies of supporting animals to persons in need.

### Looking into the Future

The year ahead shall be met with unrepresented challenges and opportunities. We believe by working together with all members of our staff, volunteers, supporting entities in our society and the entire team, we can overcome these difficulties and challenges to achieve our targets. We shall continue to provide and improve the standards of our Seeing Eye Dogs to service the visually impaired to assist and provide them with the best support as well as continuing to work on public awareness and understanding of Seeing Eye Dog and to gain their support.

Finally, we would like to sincerely thank all who has supported and donated generously to HKSEDS. With your dedicated support, we have been able to continue with our mission in providing essential Service to the visually impaired during these difficult times. We shall walk together and bring a brighter future and accept those in need of our support in an inclusive and caring society.
